



J.M. MACBETH AWARD OF MERIT

The J.M. Macbeth Award of Merit is presented in recognition of exceptional service at the chapter level. The award honours the first President of CGA-BC to be elected from outside the lower mainland area.

Nominations must demonstrate outstanding service in two key areas, Dedication and Leadership. To be considered for the J.M. Macbeth Award the nominee must have contributed to the growth of their chapter, working to advance initiatives and encourage participation.

The demonstration of exceptional service at the chapter level should be evidenced by:

Dedication

The nominee must have contributed to the growth of their chapter, advancing chapter initiatives through their willingness to contribute and their commitment. A minimum of five years of service on the provincial chapter board is required.

Leadership

The nominee has worked with their colleagues to achieve the Association's goals for the chapter, being:

- (a) develop a spirit of comradeship among members and to encourage an interchange of knowledge;
- (b) assist in the implementation of the Association's programs; and
- (c) encourage participation by members in the affairs of the Association.

Eligibility

The individual nominated must be a CGA-BC member or a CGA-BC student. Only one candidate per chapter can be nominated each year.

Nomination

Nominations can be made by any two members of the chapter board. The [nomination form](#) must be completed and signed and accompanied by a narrative describing the nominee's demonstrated qualities as outlined, together with a complete listing of their years of chapter service and positions held, along with any appropriate documentation.

Completed nominations must be received by March 15th of each year. The nomination is judged solely on the information provided.



J.M. MACBETH AWARD OF MERIT: Guidelines for Completion of the Nomination

The J.M. Macbeth Award recognizes exceptional service at the chapter level.

Nominations must provide evidence in two key areas: Dedication and Leadership.

The information and documentation provided to the Honours & Awards Committee must clearly identify the nominee as a CGA-BC member or CGA-BC student and reflect the activities being recognized in the narrative.

The individual being nominated must have a minimum of five years of service at the provincial chapter level.

The nomination must provide information and examples regarding the nominee's participation in advancing chapter initiatives and their active participation in the implementation of programs to encourage participation and the exchange of knowledge.

Consider including information on:

- active participation in student and member events
- development of PD programs and offerings
- invigilating
- involvement in local board groups such as the chamber of commerce
- development and ongoing support of community activities
- contributing to the board's development through active recruitment and succession planning
- taking a leadership role on the chapter board

Include evidence or examples of participation and acknowledgement:

- details of participation on the chapter board, including years of service and position held
- newsletter articles and announcements
- letters of support

Contributions at the provincial chapter level enhance the professional image of Certified General Accountants and encourage members to participate in their Association.

The nominee is expected to have contributed to the Association's goals and taken a leadership role in the implementation of programs that further chapter initiatives.
